Community Garden



If you've been into Par recently, you won't have failed to notice the disappearance of the old fire engines from the land next to the Community Garden. They had stood there for years and gradually deteriorated and become more and more unsightly.



Now they have been removed, work has begun on transforming the land. A grant of £2000 from Par Bay Big Local allowed for clearance of all the brambles and trees by the Heyward team. Part of the grant was used for rebuilding and repair of the front wall to provide a safe, neat boundary and discourage opportunistic parking. The next stage has already begun, to level the land as far as possible. The remaining stones and blocks (including two concrete lintels) have been removed, and the concrete floors and paths from the old house are being uncovered.



Work is now focussing on removing roots and stones and levelling out high points and low points to give as level a space as possible. The plan is for additional levelling of the ground, and then regular strimming to keep down weeds and grass to a point where it can be used for events. We're also going to make a path using donated slabs. This is a real community volunteer effort. If you have an hour or two spare on a Sunday morning, come along and lend a hand. The name for the space has been discussed by the Garden Team, and our consensus is for it to be called Jubilee Corner. It is at a corner of the 'Par Triangle' (opposite

Hamley's Corner), and it dates from the year of the Jubilee.
